


Weekly English classes and dinner provides a casual environment for students and tutors to interact.

- 10 missions since 2007
  - Recent Missions:
    - Winter 2013~2014 Saved a young woman with severe frostbite in need of medical attention and unable to continue her escape
    - July 2011 Rescued a young girl from human trafficking
