# WHO WE ARE

- A non-religious, non-partisan, non-profit organization founded in 2006 by Kim Young-II, a North Korean refugee.
- A tax-exempt NGO registered with the South Korean Ministries of Unification, and Strategy and Finance.
- The only NGO focusing exclusively on North Korean Human Rights recognized by the UN Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) as having a special consultative status which allows us to participate in UN proceedings.

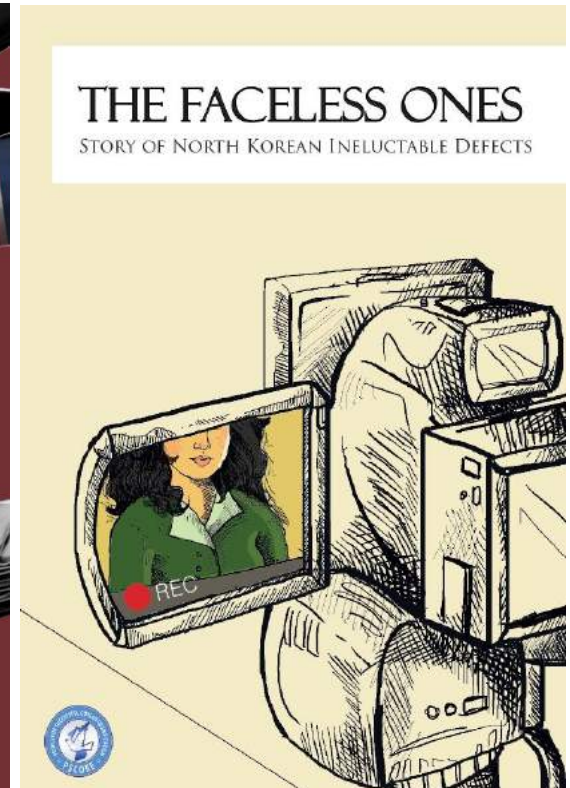
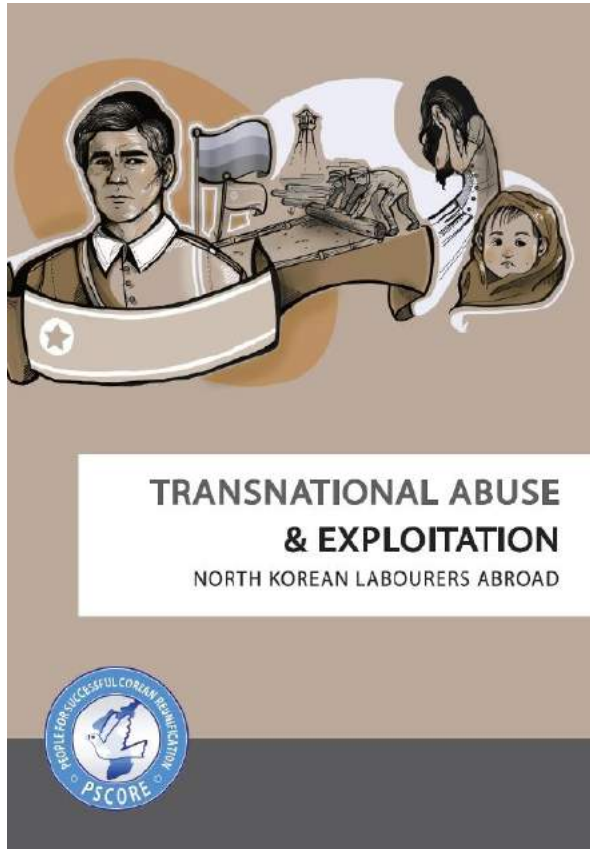

## ENGLISH LESSONS



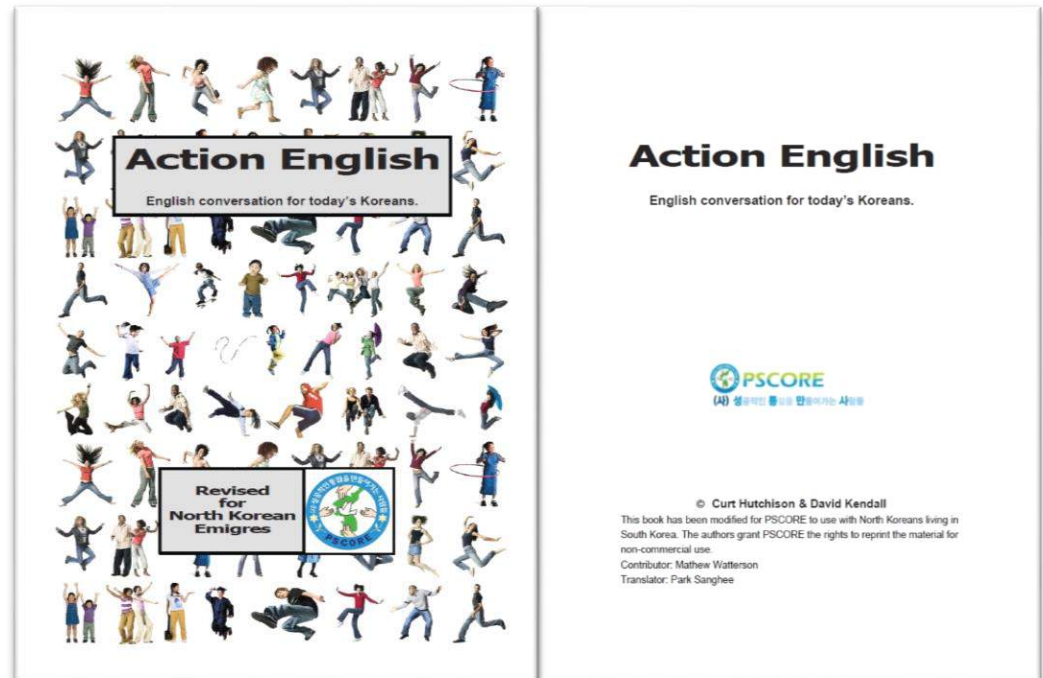
**Weekly English classes and dinner provides a casual environment for students and tutors to interact.**

    - July 2011 – Rescued a young girl from human trafficking

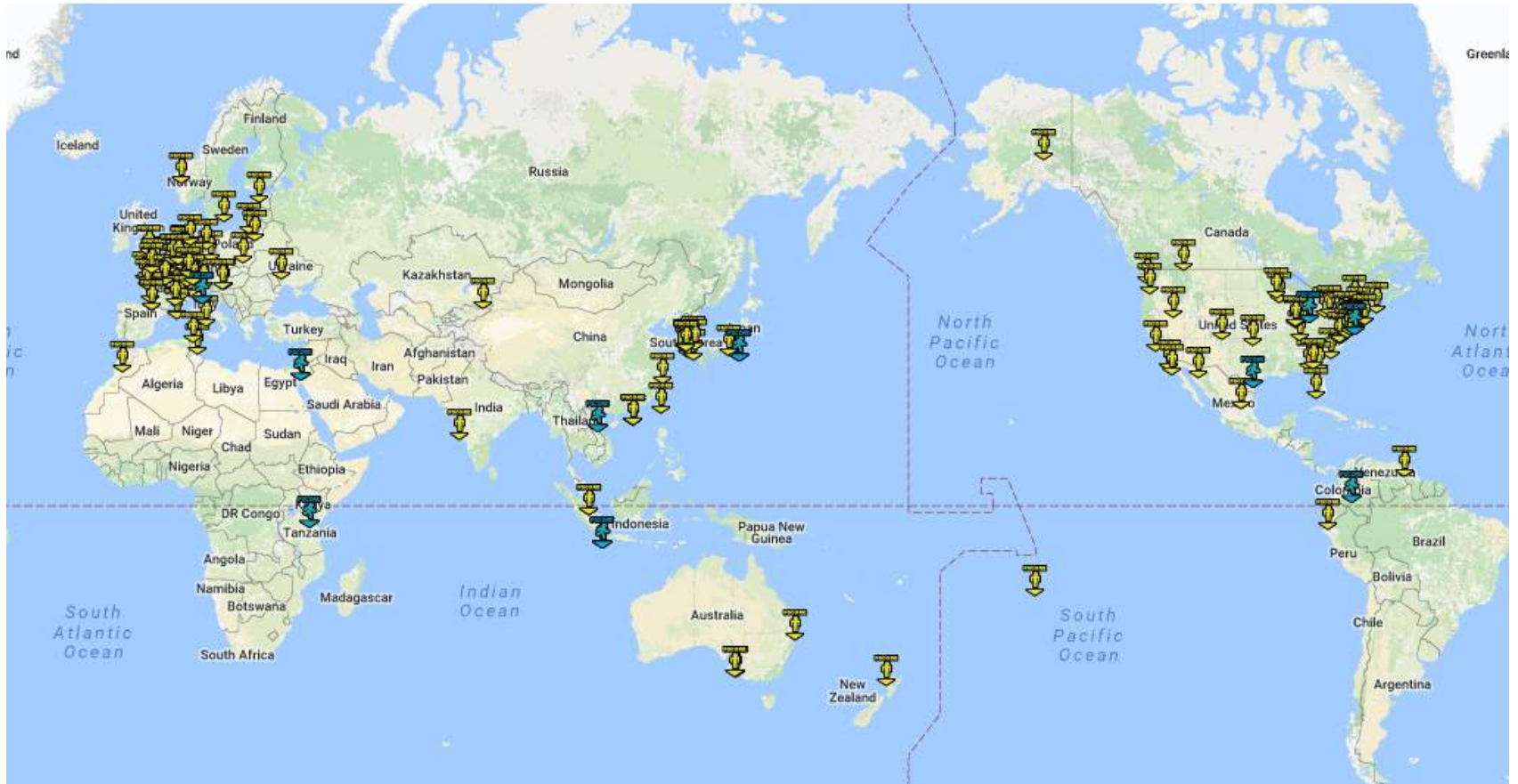
